A BILL

To require a report setting forth the global strategy of the
United States to combat and defeat al Qaeda and its
affiliates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON UNITED STATES GLOBAL STRAT-**
4 **EGY TO COMBAT AND DEFEAT AL QAEDA AND**
5 **ITS AFFILIATES.**

6 (a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than 60 days
7 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary

1 of Defense, the Secretary of State, and the Secretary of
2 Homeland Security, in coordination with the Chairman of
3 the Joint Chiefs of Staff and the Director of National In-
4 telligence, shall jointly submit to Congress a report setting
5 forth the global strategy of the United States to combat
6 and defeat al Qaeda and its affiliates.

7 (b) ELEMENTS OF STRATEGY.—The strategy set
8 forth in the report required under subsection (a) shall in-
9 clude the following elements:

10 (1) An analysis of the global threat posed by al
11 Qaeda and its affiliates, including an assessment of
12 the relative threat posed in particular regions or
13 countries.

14 (2) Recommendations regarding the distribution
15 and deployment of United States military, intel-
16 ligence, diplomatic, and other assets to meet the rel-
17 ative regional and country-specific threats described
18 in paragraph (1).

19 (3) Recommendations to ensure that the global
20 deployment of United States military personnel and
21 equipment best meets the threat identified in de-
22 scribed in paragraph (1) and does not—

23 (A) undermine the military readiness or
24 homeland security of the United States;

1 (B) require the deployment of reserve units
2 more than once every four years, or of regular
3 units more than once every two years; or

4 (C) require further extensions of deploy-
5 ments of members of the United States Armed
6 Forces.
