A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to make technical corrections to the renewable fuel standard.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO RENEWABLE**
4 **FUEL STANDARD.**

5 (a) Section 211 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
6 7545) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (c)(1), by inserting “(A)”
8 after “nonroad vehicle”;

9 (2) in subsection (o)—

1 (A) in paragraph (5)(C), by striking “12
2 months” and inserting “36 months”; and

3 (B) in paragraph (9)(A)(i), by striking
4 “2011” and inserting “2013”;

5 (3) by redesignating subsection (q) (as added
6 by section 1506 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005)
7 as subsection (p);

8 (4) by moving subsection (p) (as so redesign-
9 nated) to appear after subsection (o); and

10 (5) by redesignating subsections (r) through (v)
11 as subsections (q) through (u), respectively.

12 (b) Section 212(b) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
13 7546(b)) is amended—

14 (1) in paragraph (1)—

15 (A) by striking “title XIV of the Energy
16 Policy Act” and inserting “title XV of the En-
17 ergy Policy Act of 2005 (42 U.S.C. 16501 et
18 seq.)”; and

19 (B) by striking “sucrose-derived”; and

20 (2) in paragraph (2)(A), by striking “sucrose-
21 derived”.

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
