## A BILL

To provide for enhanced reimbursement of servicemembers and veterans for certain travel expenses.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Citizen Soldier and
- 5 Military Veteran Travel Reimbursement Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. VETERANS BENEFICIARY TRAVEL PROGRAM.

1	SEC. 3. TRAVEL AND TRANSPORTATION ALLOWANCES FOR
2	MEMBERS OF THE RESERVE COMPONENTS
3	FOR LONG DISTANCE TRAVEL TO INACTIVE
4	DUTY TRAINING.
5	(a) Allowances Authorized.—
6	(1) In General.—Chapter 7 of title 37, United
7	States Code, is amended by inserting after section
8	411j the following new section:
9	"§ 411k. Travel and transportation allowances: long
10	distance travel to inactive duty training
11	performed by members of the reserve
12	components of the armed forces
13	"(a) ALLOWANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary con-
14	cerned may reimburse a member of a reserve component
15	of the armed forces for expenses incurred in connection
16	with round-trip travel in excess of 100 miles to an inactive
17	duty training location, including mileage traveled and
18	lodging and subsistence.
19	"(b) Rates of Reimbursement.—
20	"(1) Mileage.—In determining the amount of
21	allowances or reimbursement to be paid for mileage
22	traveled under this section, the Secretary concerned
23	shall use the mileage reimbursement rate for the use
24	of privately owned vehicles by Government employees
25	on official business (when a Government vehicle is

- available), as prescribed by the Administrator of General Services under section 5707(b) of title 5.
- "(2) Lodging and subsistence.—In determining the amount of allowances or reimbursement to be paid for lodging and subsistence under this section, the Secretary concerned shall use the per diem rate as prescribed by the Administrator of General Services under section 5707 of title 5.
- "(3) AUTHORITY TO REIMBURSE AT HIGHER
  RATES.—Subject to the availability of appropriations
  and the approval of the Secretary of Defense, the
  Secretary concerned may modify the amount of allowances or reimbursement to be paid under this
  section using reimbursement rates in excess of those
  prescribed under paragraphs (1) and (2).
- "(c) Regulations.—The Secretary concerned shall prescribe regulations to carry out this section. Regulations prescribed by the Secretary of a military department shall be subject to the approval of the Secretary of Defense.".
- 20 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections 21 at the beginning of chapter 7 of such title is amended by
- 22 inserting after the item relating to section 411j the fol-
- 23 lowing new item:

"411k. Travel and transportation allowances: long distance travel to inactive duty training performed by members of the reserve components of the armed forces.".

### 1 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 2 The amendments made by this Act shall apply with
- 3 respect to travel expenses incurred after the expiration of
- 4 the 90-day period that begins on the date of the enactment

5 of this Act.
