- 6 The Secretary of Defense may not transport hydroly-
- 7 sate from the Pueblo Chemical Depot, Colorado, to an off-
- 8 site location for treatment, storage, or disposal. Nothing
- 9 in this Act limits or otherwise affects the obligation of the
- 10 Secretary of Defense to complete work on the destruction

- 1 of the United States stockpile of lethal chemical weapons
- 2 and munitions under section 8119 of the Department of
- 3 Defense Appropriations Act, 2008 (Public Law 110–116;
