- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicaid Levy En-
- 5 hancement Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CONTINUOUS LEVY ON PAYMENTS TO MEDICAID
- 7 PROVIDERS AND SUPPLIERS.
- 8 (a) In General.—Section 6331(h)(2) of the Inter-
- 9 nal Revenue Code of 1986 (defining specified payment)
- 10 is amended by striking "and" at the end of subparagraph

- 1 (B), by striking the period at the end of subparagraph
- 2 (C) and inserting ", and", and by adding at the end the
- 3 following new subparagraph:
- 4 "(D) any payment to any medicaid pro-
- 5 vider or supplier under a State plan under title
- 6 XIX of the Social Security Act.".
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 8 this section shall apply to levies issued after the date of
- 9 the enactment of this Act.
