- 3 SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF THE CAP ON DISPROPORTIONATE
- 4 SHARE ADJUSTMENT PERCENTAGES FOR
- 5 CERTAIN RURAL HOSPITALS.
- 6 Section 1886(d)(5)(F)(xiv)(II) of the Social Security
- 7 Act (42 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)(5)(F)(xiv)(II)) is amended by
- 8 striking "12 percent" and inserting "12 percent. The pre-
- 9 ceding sentence shall not apply to a hospital that, in the
- 10 case of discharges occurring on or after April 1, 2004,

- 1 is classified as a rural referral center under subparagraph
- 2 (C), that, in the case of discharges occurring on or after
- 3 October 1, 2006, is classified as a medicare-dependant,
- 4 small rural hospital under subparagraph (G)(iv), or that,
- 5 in the case of discharges occurring on or after October
- 6 1, 2008, is located in a rural area and has more than 100

7 beds.".
