- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Fisheries Capital Con-
- 5 struction Fund Enhancement Act of 2008".

SECTION 2. CERTAIN QUALIFIED CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION 2 FUND WITHDRAWALS. 3 Section 53509 of title 46, United States Code, is 4 amended— (1) by striking "or" after the semicolon in 5 6 paragraph (1) of subsection (a); 7 (2) by redesignating paragraph (2) of sub-8 section (a) as paragraph (3); (3) by inserting after paragraph (1) of sub-9 10 section (a) the following: 11 "(2) the acquisition of gear or equipment re-12 quired for safety of life at sea or to comply with con-13 servation measures within a fishery; or"; and (4) by inserting after "withdrawal." in sub-14 15 section (c) the following: "The minimum cost requirements established by such regulations (50 16 17 C.F.R. 259.31) shall not apply to a withdrawal de-
