To require disclosure by Federal contractors of certain violations relating to the award or performance of Federal contracts.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Close the Contractor
- 5 Fraud Loophole Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. REVISION OF THE FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULA-
- 7 **TION.**
- 8 The Federal Acquisition Regulation shall be amended
- 9 within 180 days after the date of the enactment of this
- 10 Act pursuant to FAR Case 2007–006 (as published at 72

- 1 Fed. Reg. 64019, November 14, 2007) or any follow-on
- 2 FAR case to include provisions that require timely notifi-
- 3 cation by Federal contractors of violations of Federal
- 4 criminal law or overpayments in connection with the
- 5 award or performance of covered contracts or sub-
- 6 contracts, including those performed outside the United
- 7 States and those for commercial items.
- 8 SEC. 3. DEFINITION.
- 9 In this Act, the term "covered contract" means any
- 10 contract in an amount greater than \$5,000,000 and more
- 11 than 120 days in duration.
