To amend title II of the Social Security Act to prohibit the display of Social Security account numbers on Medicare cards.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Medicare Card Secu-
- 5 rity Act of 2008".

- 1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF THE DISPLAY OF SOCIAL SECU-
- 2 RITY ACCOUNT NUMBERS ON MEDICARE
- 3 CARDS.
- 4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 205(c)(2)(C) of the Social
- 5 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 405(c)(2)(C)) is amended by add-
- 6 ing at the end the following new clause:
- 7 "(x) The Commissioner of Social Security and the
- 8 Secretary of Health and Human Services jointly shall es-
- 9 tablish cost-effective procedures to ensure that a social se-
- 10 curity account number (or any derivative thereof) is not
- 11 displayed on the Medicare card issued to an individual who
- 12 is entitled to benefits under part A of title XVIII or en-
- 13 rolled under part B of title XVIII.".
- 14 (b) Funding.—Notwithstanding any other provision
- 15 of law, of the amounts appropriated for administrative ex-
- 16 penses of the Department of Health and Human Services
- 17 for fiscal years beginning with fiscal year 2008, such sums
- 18 as are necessary to carry out the amendment made by sub-
- 19 section (a) shall be available from such amounts for such
- 20 purpose.
- 21 (c) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 22 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to Medicare cards
- 23 issued on and after the date that is 1 year after the date
- 24 of the enactment of this Act.
