## A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to provide for the study of the Western States Trail.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Western States Trail
- 5 Study Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. WESTERN STATES TRAIL STUDY.
- 7 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16
- 8 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended—
- 9 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (42) and (41)
- as paragraphs (41) and (42), respectively; and

1	(2) by adding at the end the following:
2	"(44) Western States Trail.—The Western
3	States Trail, a trail of approximately 100 miles from
4	Squaw Valley to Auburn, California (including the
5	Tevis Cup Loop)—
6	"(A) as displayed on the maps maintained
7	in the office of the American River District
8	Ranger, Tahoe National Forest;
9	"(B) as described in the journal of Pro-
10	fessor William Brewer for August 30, 1863;
11	and
12	"(C) along which are conducted—
13	"(i) the Western States Trail Ride;
14	and
15	"(ii) the Western States Endurance
16	Run.".
