## A BILL

To amend the Vietnam Education Foundation Act of 2000.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Vietnam Education
- 5 Foundation Amendments Act of 2008".

- 10 cational and Cultural Affairs may hire personnel who were
- 11 employed by the Vietnam Education Foundation on the
- 12 date before the date of the enactment of this Act, and
- 13 such other personnel as may be necessary to support the
- 14 Foundation, in accordance with part III of title 5, United
- 15 States Code.

### 16 SEC. 3. AMERICAN RESEARCH COLLEGE IN VIETNAM.

- 17 (a) Grants Authorized.—The Secretary of State,
- 18 acting through the Assistant Secretary for Educational
- 19 and Cultural Affairs, is authorized to award 1 or more
- 20 grants to institutions of higher education (as defined in
- 21 section 101(a) of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
- 22 U.S.C. 1001(a))), which shall be used to participate in a
- 23 partnership with the Government of the Socialist Republic
- 24 of Vietnam to establish an American Research College in
- 25 Vietnam. The purpose of the American Research College

- 1 shall be to provide a high quality general education to Vi-
- 2 etnamese undergraduate students.
- 3 (b) Application.—
- 4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Each institution of higher 5 education desiring the grant under this section shall 6 submit an application to the Secretary of State at 7 such time, in such manner, and accompanied by 8 such information as the Secretary may reasonably 9 require.
- 10 (2) Competitive basis.—Each grant author-11 ized under subsection (a) shall be awarded on a 12 competitive basis.
- 13 (c) Source of Grant Funds.—The Secretary of
- 14 State may use funds made available to the Vietnam Edu-
- 15 cation Foundation under section 207(c) of the Vietnam
- 16 Education Foundation Act of 2000 (22 U.S.C. 2452 note)
- 17 for the grant awarded under this section.
- 18 (d) Limitation.—The Secretary of State shall en-
- 19 courage the Government of the Socialist Republic of Viet-
- 20 nam to make an appropriate financial or in-kind contribu-
- 21 tion to establish and maintain the college established with
- 22 grant funds awarded under this section.

### 1 SEC. 4. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 2 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall
- 3 take effect on the date that is 90 days after the date of
- 4 the enactment of this Act.
