A BILL

For the relief of Jorge Rojas Gutierrez, Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, and Jorge Rojas Gonzalez.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR JORGE

ROJAS GUTIERREZ, OLIVA GONZALEZ GON
ZALEZ, AND JORGE ROJAS GONZALEZ.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)

and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality

Act (8 U.S.C. 1151), Jorge Rojas Gutierrez, Oliva Gon
zalez Gonzalez, and Jorge Rojas Gonzalez shall each be

eligible for the issuance of an immigrant visa or for adjust-

- 1 ment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted for
- 2 permanent residence upon filing an application for
- 3 issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such
- 4 Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi-
- 5 dent.
- 6 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Jorge Rojas
- 7 Gutierrez, Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, and Jorge Rojas Gon-
- 8 zalez enters the United States before the filing deadline
- 9 specified in subsection (c), Jorge Rojas Gutierrez, Oliva
- 10 Gonzalez Gonzalez, and Jorge Rojas Gonzalez shall be
- 11 considered to have entered and remained lawfully in the
- 12 United States and shall be eligible for adjustment of sta-
- 13 tus under section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality
- 14 Act (8 U.S.C. 1255) as of the date of the enactment of
- 15 this Act.
- 16 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 17 Fees.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 18 plication for the issuance of an immigrant visa or the ap-
- 19 plication for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate
- 20 fees not later than 2 years after the date of the enactment
- 21 of this Act.
- 22 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Numbers.—
- 23 Upon granting an immigrant visa or permanent residence
- 24 to Jorge Rojas Gutierrez, Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, and
- 25 Jorge Rojas Gonzalez, the Secretary of State shall instruct

- 1 the proper officer to reduce by 3, during the current or
- 2 next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant
- 3 visas that are made available to natives of the country of
- 4 birth of Jorge Rojas Gutierrez, Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez,
- 5 and Jorge Rojas Gonzalez under section 203(a) of the Im-
- 6 migration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the total
- 7 number of immigrant visas that are made available to na-
- 8 tives of the country of birth of Jorge Rojas Gutierrez,
- 9 Oliva Gonzalez Gonzalez, and Jorge Rojas Gonzalez under
- 10 section 202(e) of such Act.
