## A BILL

To amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act with respect to priority review vouchers.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS REGARDING PRIORITY REVIEW 4 **VOUCHERS.** 5 Section 524(b) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. 360n(b)) is amended— 7 (1) by amending paragraph (2) to read as fol-8 lows: 9 "(2) Transferability.—Priority review

vouchers shall be transferrable (including by sale).

1	Entities eligible to participate in such transfers in-
2	clude sponsors of a human drug application under
3	section $505(b)(1)$ or section $351$ of the Public
4	Health Service Act."; and
5	(2) in paragraph (3), by adding at the end the
6	following:
7	"(C) No effect on pending review.—
8	A priority review voucher may not be redeemed
9	to affect the review of a pending human drug
10	application under section $505(b)(1)$ or section
11	351 of the Public Health Service Act.".
