A BILL

To amend title 46, United States Code, with respect to the navigation of submersible or semi-submersible vessels without nationality.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. OPERATION OF SUBMERSIBLE OR SEMI-SUBMERSIBLE VESSEL WITHOUT NATIONALITY.
