To extend immigration programs to promote legal immigration and for other purposes.

- This Act may be cited as the "Legal Immigration Ex-
- 5 tension Act of 2008".

- 8 sion" and inserting "shall set aside 3,000 visas annually
- 9 for 20 years to include such aliens as are eligible for ad-
