A BILL

To designate the North Palisade in the Sierra Nevada in the State of California as "Brower Palisade" in honor of the late David Brower.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Brower Palisade Des-
- 5 ignation Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDINGS.
- 7 Congress finds that—

1	(1) David Brower dedicated his life to environ-
2	mental advocacy and was 1 of the most notable envi-
3	ronmental stewards of the United States;
4	(2) former Secretary of the Interior Stewart
5	Udall referred to David Brower as the "giant of
6	20th Century conservation in the United States";
7	(3) David Brower was nominated for the Nobel
8	Peace Prize 3 times;
9	(4) David Brower was named the first executive
10	director of the Sierra Club, 1 of the most prominent
11	environmental and conservation organizations in the
12	United States;
13	(5) the efforts of David Brower led to the cre-
14	ation of many units of the National Park System,
15	including North Cascades National Park, Redwood
16	National Park, and Point Reyes National Seashore;
17	(6) the leadership of David Brower helped pro-
18	tect the Grand Canyon National Park and Dinosaur
19	National Monument;
20	(7) David Brower played a important role in
21	drafting the Wilderness Act (16 U.S.C. 1131 et
22	seq.), which has protected much of the Sierra Ne-
23	vada;
24	(8) David Brower revolutionized rock-climbing
25	and mountaineering in the United States and is

- 1 credited with more than 70 first ascents of Sierra
- 2 Nevada peaks;
- 3 (9) David Brower made the first winter ascent
- 4 of North Palisade and the first ascent of the North-
- 5 west Ridge of the peak; and
- 6 (10) the Palisade group of peaks, on the border
- 7 of Kings Canyon National Park and Inyo National
- 8 Forest, was David Brower's favorite part of the Si-
- 9 erra Nevada.

10 SEC. 3. DESIGNATION OF BROWER PALISADE.

- 11 (a) Designation.—The North Palisade, a promi-
- 12 nent peak in the Palisade group of peaks in the Sierra
- 13 Nevada bordering Kings Canyon National Park and the
- 14 Inyo National Forest in the State of California, shall be
- 15 known and designated as the "Brower Palisade".
- 16 (b) References.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
- 17 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
- 18 States to the peak described in subsection (a) shall be
- 19 deemed to be a reference to the Brower Palisade.
