## A BILL

To ban the exportation of crude oil produced on Federal land, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "American Oil for
- 5 American Families Act of 2008".
- 6 SEC. 2. BAN ON EXPORTING CRUDE OIL PRODUCED ON
- 7 FEDERAL LAND.
- 8 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 9 sion of law, petroleum extracted from public lands in the
- 10 United States (including lands located on the outer conti-

1	nental shelf), or a petroleum product produced from such
2	petroleum, may not be exported from the United States.
3	(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
4	(1) Petroleum product.—The term "petro-
5	leum product" means any of the following:
6	(A) Finished reformulated or conventional
7	motor gasoline.
8	(B) Finished aviation gasoline.
9	(C) Kerosene-type jet fuel.
10	(D) Kerosene.
11	(E) Distillate fuel oil.
12	(F) Residual fuel oil.
13	(G) Lubricants.
14	(H) Waxes.
15	(I) Petroleum coke.
16	(J) Asphalt and road oil.
17	(2) Public lands.—The term "public lands"
18	means any land and interest in land owned by the
19	United States within the several States and adminis-
20	tered by the Secretary of the Interior through the
21	Bureau of Land Management or the Minerals Man-
22	agement Service, without regard to how the United
23	States acquired ownership.
