To require the Secretary of the Treasury to mint coins in commemoration of the legacy of the United States Army Infantry and the establishment of the National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center.

## A BILL

- To require the Secretary of the Treasury to mint coins in commemoration of the legacy of the United States Army Infantry and the establishment of the National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Infantry Mu-
  - 5 seum and Soldier Center Commemorative Coin Act of
  - 6 2008".

### SEC. 2. COIN SPECIFICATIONS.

- 2 (a) \$1 SILVER COINS.—The Secretary of the Treas-

- 4 shall mint and issue not more than 350,000 \$1 coins in
- 5 commemoration of the legacy of the United States Army

- 9 (2) have a diameter of 1.500 inches; and
- 10 (3) contain 90 percent silver and 10 percent

- 19 SEC. 3. DESIGN OF COINS.

- courage, pride, sacrifice, sense of duty, and history

1	(c) Period of Issuance.—The Secretary may issue

4	SEC. 5. SALE OF COINS.
5	(a) Sale Price.—The coins issued under this Act
6	shall be sold by the Secretary at a price equal to the sum
7	of—
8	(1) the face value of the coins;
9	(2) the surcharge provided in section 6 with re-
10	spect to such coins; and
11	(3) the cost of designing and issuing the coins
12	(including labor, materials, dies, use of machinery,
13	overhead expenses, marketing, and shipping).
14	(b) Bulk Sales.—The Secretary shall make bulk
15	sales of the coins issued under this Act at a reasonable
16	discount.
17	(c) Prepaid Orders.—
18	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall accept
19	prepaid orders for the coins minted under this Act
20	before the issuance of such coins.
21	(2) DISCOUNT.—Sale prices with respect to pre-
22	paid orders under paragraph (1) shall be at a rea-
23	sonable discount.

#### 1 SEC. 6. SURCHARGES.

- 2 (a) In General.—All sales of coins issued under this
- 3 Act shall include a surcharge of \$10 per coin.
- 4 (b) DISTRIBUTION.—Subject to section 5134(f) of
- 5 title 31, United States Code, all surcharges received by
- 6 the Secretary from the sale of coins issued under this Act
- 7 shall be paid to the National Infantry Foundation for the
- 8 purpose of establishing an endowment to support the
- 9 maintenance of the National Infantry Museum and Soldier
- 10 Center following its completion.
- 11 (c) AUDITS.—The Comptroller General of the United
- 12 States shall have the right to examine such books, records,
- 13 documents, and other data of the National Infantry Foun-
- 14 dation as may be related to the expenditures of amounts
- 15 paid under subsection (b).
- 16 (d) Limitation.—Notwithstanding subsection (a),
- 17 no surcharge may be included with respect to the issuance
- 18 under this Act of any coin during a calendar year if, as
- 19 of the time of such issuance, the issuance of such coin
- 20 would result in the number of commemorative coin pro-
- 21 grams issued during such year to exceed the annual 2
- 22 commemorative coin program issuance limitation under
- 23 section 5112(m)(1) of title 31, United States Code (as in
- 24 effect on the date of the enactment of this Act). The Sec-
