## A BILL

To allow certain participants in the conservation reserve program to participate in the critical feed use program of the Secretary of Agriculture.

- 9 (a) Definitions.—In this section:

- 1 (1) Conservation reserve program.—The
  2 term "conservation reserve program" means the con3 servation reserve program established under sub4 chapter B of chapter 1 of subtitle D of title XII of
  5 the Food Security Act of 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3831 et
  6 seq.).
- 7 (2) Critical feed use program" means the program de-8 "critical feed use program" means the program de-9 scribed in the notice entitled "Notice of Voluntary 10 Modification of Conservation Reserve Program Con-11 tract" (73 Fed. Reg. 31053), dated May 30, 2008.
- (3) SECRETARY.—The term "Secretary" means
   the Secretary of Agriculture.

14 (b) AUTHORITY.—Notwithstanding any other provi-15 sion of law, if an owner or operator of land enrolled in the conservation reserve program submits to the Secretary 16 17 an affidavit stating that the owner or operator attempted 18 or intended to enroll in the critical feed use program prior to July 8, 2008, the Secretary shall modify the conserva-19 20 tion reserve program contract of the owner or operator 21 to allow critical feed use (including having or grazing) of the enrolled land in accordance with the terms and conditions of the critical feed use program.
