A BILL

To prohibit the use of funds for the establishment of National Marine Monuments unless certain requirements are met.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. MARINE MONUMENTS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 5 sion of law, no funds made available under any Act mak-
- 6 ing appropriations for fiscal year 2008 or 2009 may be
- 7 used to establish a national monument or otherwise convey
- 8 protected status to any area in the marine environment
- 9 of the Exclusive Economic Zone of the United States
- 10 under the Act of June 8, 1906 (16 U.S.C. 431 et seq.).

- 1 (b) STUDY.—Not later than 180 days after the date
- 2 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Commerce may,
- 3 as applicable, and in compliance with all requirements
- 4 under title III of the National Marine Sanctuaries Act (16
- 5 U.S.C. 1431 et seq.) (including the procedures for des-
- 6 ignation and implementation under section 304 of that Act
- 7 (16 U.S.C. 1434)) with respect to any proposed protected
- 8 area, submit to Congress a study of the proposed pro-
