To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide a temporary increase in the new qualified hybrid motor vehicle credit for school buses.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. TEMPORARY INCREASE IN NEW QUALIFIED HY-4 BRID MOTOR VEHICLE CREDIT FOR SCHOOL 5 BUSES. 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 30B(d)(2)(B) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the 8 end the following new clause: 9 "(vi) TEMPORARY **INCREASE** FOR

SCHOOL BUSES.—In the case of any new

1	qualified hybrid motor vehicle which is a
2	school bus (as defined in section
3	4221(d)(7)(C)), the dollar amounts speci-
4	fied in clause (iii) shall be increased by—
5	"(I) 200 percent for vehicles
6	placed in service before January 1,
7	2010,
8	"(II) 150 percent for vehicles
9	placed in service after December 31,
10	2009, and before January 1, 2011,
11	"(III) 100 percent for vehicles
12	placed in service after December 31,
13	2010, and before January 1, 2012,
14	and
15	"(IV) 50 percent for vehicles
16	placed in service after December 31,
17	2011, and before January 1, 2013.".
18	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 30B(j)(3)
19	of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by in-
20	serting "(December 31, 2012, in the case of a school
21	bus)".
22	(c) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
23	this section shall apply to vehicles placed in service after
24	the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
