An Act

To extend the pilot program for volunteer groups to obtain criminal history back-  
ground checks.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of  
the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

This Act may be cited as the “Criminal History Background  
Checks Pilot Extension Act of 2008”.

**SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF PILOT PROGRAM.**

Section 108(a)(3)(A) of the PROTECT Act (42 U.S.C. 5119a  
note) is amended by striking “a 66-month” and inserting “a 78-  
month”.
