2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON THE UNITED STATES SHARE OF**
2 **ASSESSMENTS FOR UNITED NATIONS PEACE-**
3 **KEEPING OPERATIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 404(b)(2)(B) of the For-
5 eign Relations Authorization Act, Fiscal Years 1994 and
6 1995 (Public Law 103–236; 22 U.S.C. 287e note) is
7 amended by adding at the end the following new clause:

8 “(v) For assessments made during
9 calendar years 2005, 2006, 2007, and
10 2008, 27.1 percent.”.

11 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 411 of the
12 Department of State and Related Agency Appropriations
13 Act, 2005 (title IV of division B of Public Law 108–447;
14 22 U.S.C. 287e note) is repealed.
