A BILL

To designate the National Museum of Wildlife Art, located at 2820 Rungius Road, Jackson, Wyoming, as the “National Museum of Wildlife Art of the United States”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL MUSEUM OF WILDLIFE ART OF THE**
4 **UNITED STATES.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The National Museum of Wild-
6 life Art, located at 2820 Rungius Road, Jackson, Wyo-
7 ming, shall be known and designated as the “National Mu-
8 seum of Wildlife Art of the United States”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the museum referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the “National Museum of
5 Wildlife Art of the United States”.
