Mr. DOMENICI (for himself and Mr. BINGAMAN) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To increase the number of Deputy United States Marshals
that investigate immigration crimes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. DEPUTY UNITED STATES MARSHALS.

4 (a) INCREASE POSITIONS.—In each of the fiscal
5 years 2008 through 2012, the Attorney General, subject
6 to the availability of appropriations, shall increase by not
7 less than 50 the number of positions for full-time active
8 duty Deputy United States Marshals that investigate
9 criminal matters related to immigration.

1 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
2 are authorized to be appropriated to the Attorney General
3 such sums as may be necessary for each of the fiscal years
4 2008 through 2012 to carry out subsection (a).
