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# A BILL

To create a Rural Policing Institute as part of the Federal  
Law Enforcement Training Center.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. RURAL POLICING INSTITUTE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—There is established a Rural Po-  
5       licing Institute, which shall be administered by the Office  
6       of State and Local Training of the Federal Law Enforce-  
7       ment Training Center (based in Glynn, Georgia), to—

8                   (1) evaluate the needs of law enforcement agen-  
9                   cies of units of local government and tribal govern-  
10                  ments located in rural areas;

17 (b) CURRICULA.—The training at the Rural Policing  
18 Institute established under subsection (a) shall be config-  
19 ured in a manner so as to not duplicate or displace any  
20 law enforcement program of the Federal Law Enforce-  
21 ment Training Center in existence on the date of enact-  
22 ment of this Act.

23 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “rural”  
24 means area that is not located in a metropolitan statistical  
25 area, as defined by the Office of Management and Budget.

1           (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There  
2 are authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section  
3 (including for contracts, staff, and equipment)—  
4           (1) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2008; and  
5           (2) \$5,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2009  
6 through 2013.

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
