## A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Local Government Dis-
- 5 aster Relief Act of 2007".
- 6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL SHARE.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 8 sion of law, the Federal share of any assistance provided
- 9 under section 406 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Re-
- 10 lief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5172) be-

- 1 cause of Hurricane Katrina of 2005 or Hurricane Rita
- 2 of 2005 shall be 100 percent.
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—This section shall apply to
- 4 any assistance provided under section 406 of the Robert
- 5 T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
- 6 (42 U.S.C. 5172) on or after August 28, 2005.
