A BILL

To amend the National Trails System Act to designate the Washington-Rochambeau Revolutionary Route National Historic Trail.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Washington-Rocham-
3 beau Revolutionary Route National Historic Trail Des-
4 ignation Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. ADDITION TO NATIONAL SCENIC AND NATIONAL**
6 **HISTORIC TRAILS.**

7 Section 5(a) of the National Trails System Act (16
8 U.S.C. 1244(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(26) WASHINGTON-ROCHAMBEAU REVOLU-
11 TIONARY ROUTE NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—

12 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The Washington-Ro-
13 chambeau Revolutionary Route National His-
14 toric Trail, a corridor of approximately 600
15 miles following the route taken by the armies of
16 General George Washington and Count Ro-
17 chambeau between Newport, Rhode Island, and
18 Yorktown, Virginia, in 1781 and 1782, as gen-
19 erally depicted on the map entitled ‘WASH-
20 NGTON-ROCHAMBEAU REVOLU-
21 TIONARY ROUTE NATIONAL HISTORIC
22 TRAIL’, numbered T01/80,000, and dated July
23 2006.

24 “(B) MAP.—The map referred to in sub-
25 paragraph (A) shall be on file and available for

1 public inspection in the appropriate offices of
2 the National Park Service.

3 “(C) ADMINISTRATION.—The trail shall be
4 administered by the Secretary of the Interior,
5 in consultation with—

6 “(i) other Federal, State, tribal, re-
7 gional, and local agencies; and

8 “(ii) the private sector.

9 “(D) LAND ACQUISITION.—The United
10 States shall not acquire for the trail any land
11 or interest in land outside the exterior boundary
12 of any federally-managed area without the con-
13 sent of the owner of the land or interest in
14 land.”.
