A BILL

To amend title 4, United States Code, to authorize the Governor of a State, territory, or possession of the United States to order that the National flag be flown at half-staff in that State, territory, or possession in the event of the death of a member of the Armed Forces from that State, territory, or possession who dies while serving on active duty.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Army Specialist Joseph
3 P. Micks Federal Flag Code Amendment Act of 2007”.

4 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF GOVERNORS TO ORDER THE NA-**
5 **TIONAL FLAG TO BE FLOWN AT HALF-STAFF**
6 **IN THE EVENT OF THE DEATH OF A MEMBER**
7 **OF THE ARMED FORCES.**

8 (a) DEATH OF A MEMBER OF THE ARMED
9 FORCES.—Section 7(m) of title 4, United States Code, is
10 amended in the sixth sentence by inserting “or the death
11 of a member of the Armed Forces from any State, terri-
12 tory, or possession who dies while serving on active duty”
13 after “present or former official of the government of any
14 State, territory, or possession of the United States”.

15 (b) FEDERAL FACILITY CONSISTENCY WITH STATE
16 PROCLAMATION.—Such section is further amended by in-
17 serting after the sixth sentence the following new sentence:
18 “When the Governor of a State, territory, or possession
19 issues a proclamation under the preceding sentence that
20 the National flag be flown at half-staff because of the
21 death of a member of the Armed Forces, the National flag
22 flown at any Federal installation or facility in that State,
23 territory, or possession shall be flown at half-staff con-
24 sistent with that proclamation.”.
