Mr. LOTT introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To designate the United States courthouse to be constructed in Jackson, Mississippi, as the “Thad Cochran United States Courthouse”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States courthouse to be constructed at
5 the site bounded on the north by Court Street, on the west
6 by West Street, on the south by South Street, and on the
7 east by President Street in Jackson, Mississippi, shall be
8 known and designated as the “Thad Cochran United
9 States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the court-
4 house referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a ref-
5 erence to the “Thad Cochran United States Courthouse”.
