A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “College Opportunity
5 Act of 2007”.

1 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

2 It is the sense of Congress that the Congress should
3 enact, and the President should sign, legislation to amend
4 title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and other
5 laws and provisions to make college more affordable
6 through increased Federal Pell Grants and providing more
7 favorable student loans and other benefits.
