A BILL

To provide for funding assistance under section 406 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5172) to a State or local government for the acquisition of real property for the purpose of the replacement of certain public facilities based on reasonable reliance of cost estimates provided by the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. ASSISTANCE FOR CERTAIN PUBLIC FACILITIES**2 **DAMAGED AS A RESULT OF HURRICANE**3 **KATRINA OR HURRICANE RITA.**

4 The Administrator of the Federal Emergency Man-
5 agement Agency shall make a contribution of funds under
6 section 406 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and
7 Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5172) to a State
8 or local government for the replacement of a public facil-
9 ity, if—

10 (1) that facility was damaged as a result of
11 Hurricane Katrina or Hurricane Rita;

12 (2) based on a cost estimate provided by the
13 Federal Emergency Management Agency to that
14 State or local government, the extent of the damage
15 would require the replacement of that facility, in-
16 stead of the repair, restoration, or reconstruction of
17 that facility;

18 (3) that State or local government acquired real
19 property for the purpose of the replacement of that
20 facility based on reasonable reliance on the cost esti-
21 mate described under paragraph (2); and

22 (4) such funds would otherwise be available to
23 that State or local government for that facility in ac-
24 cordance with that Act.
