Mr. DORGAN (for himself, Mr. JOHNSON, Mr. THUNE, and Mr. CONRAD) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the awarding of the Medal of Honor to Woodrow W. Keeble for his acts of valor during the Korean conflict.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO AWARD MEDAL OF HONOR TO
4 WOODROW W. KEEBLE FOR VALOR DURING
5 THE KOREAN CONFLICT.

6 Notwithstanding the time limitations specified in sec-
7 tion 3744 of title 10, United States Code, or any other
8 time limitation with respect to the awarding of certain
9 medals to persons who served in the military, the Presi-

1 dent may award the Medal of Honor under section 3741
2 of such title to Woodrow W. Keeble for his acts of valor
3 as an acting platoon leader on October 20, 1951 during
4 the Korean conflict.
