## **RESOLUTION**

Expressing the condolences of the Nation to the community  
of Greensburg, Kansas.

Whereas, on Friday, May 4, 2007, a tornado struck the com-  
munity of Greensburg, Kansas;

Whereas this tornado was classified as an EF-5, the strongest  
possible type, by the National Weather Service, with  
winds estimated at 205 miles per hour;

Whereas the tornado is the first EF-5 on the Enhanced  
Fujita scale, and the first F-5 on the previous scale since  
1999;

Whereas approximately 95 percent of Greensburg is de-  
stroyed;

Whereas 1,500 residents have been displaced from their  
homes; and

Whereas, in response to the declaration by the President of a major disaster, the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency has made Federal disaster assistance available for the State of Kansas to assist in local recovery efforts: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*, That the Senate expresses the condolences  
2 of the Nation to the community of Greensburg, Kansas,  
3 and its gratitude to local, State, and National law enforcement and emergency responders conducting search and  
5 rescue operations.
