- 7 ate may collect from another Senator, officer, or em-

- ployee of the Senate within Senate buildings nonmonetary donations to be sent to United States military personnel on active duty overseas participating in or in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom, Operation Enduring Freedom, and the war on terrorism; and
- 7 (2) a Senator, officer, or employee of the Sen-8 ate may work with a nonprofit organization with re-9 spect to the delivery of donations that are collected 10 as described in paragraph (1).
- 11 (b) Effective Period.—This resolution shall be in 12 effect until December 31, 2007.
