CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for a conditional adjournment of the House of Representatives and a conditional recess or adjournment of the Senate.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on any legisla-
3 tive day from Thursday, July 1, 2010, through Saturday,
4 July 3, 2010, on a motion offered pursuant to this concur-
5 rent resolution by its Majority Leader or his designee, it
6 stand adjourned until 2 p.m. on Tuesday, July 13, 2010,
7 or until the time of any reassembly pursuant

1 to section 2 of this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs
2 first; and that when the Senate recesses or adjourns on
3 any day from Wednesday, June 30, 2010, through Sun-
4 day, July 4, 2010, on a motion offered pursuant to this
5 concurrent resolution by its Majority Leader or his des-
6 ignee, it stand recessed or adjourned until noon on Mon-
7 day, July 12, 2010, or such other time on that day as
8 may be specified in the motion to recess or adjourn, or
9 until the time of any reassembly pursuant to section 2 of
10 this concurrent resolution, whichever occurs first.

11 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
12 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
13 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
14 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
15 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
16 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
17 ignate if, in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant
18 it.
