Mr. CASTLE (for himself and Mr. LANCE) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress regarding the establishment of committees with jurisdiction over intelligence activities.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of Congress that begin-
3 ning with the One Hundred Twelfth Congress, the House
4 of Representatives and the Senate should, in accordance
5 with the recommendations of the National Commission on
6 Terrorist Attacks Upon the United States (commonly
7 known as the “9/11 Commission”)—

8 (1) each establish in the Committee on Appro-
9 priations of the House of Representatives or Senate
10 (as the case may be) a Subcommittee on Intel-

1 ligence, which should have jurisdiction over all ac-
2 tivities of such Committee that relate to intelligence
3 and intelligence-related activities of the United
4 States Government;

5 (2) establish a Joint Committee on Intelligence,
6 which should have jurisdiction over authorization of
7 and appropriations for intelligence and intelligence-
8 related activities of the United States Government;
9 or

10 (3) each establish a Committee on Intelligence,
11 which should have jurisdiction over authorization of
12 and appropriations for intelligence and intelligence-
13 related activities of the United States Government.
