CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the rotunda of the Capitol for the
photo exhibition “Being Untouchable” and a ceremony

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That the rotunda of the United States Cap-
3 itol is authorized to be used on December 9, 2010, for
4 the photo exhibition “Being Untouchable”, which high-
5 lights different aspects of the social exclusion, resilience,
6 and extraordinary spirit of the Dalit community in India,
7 and for a ceremony in honor of the exhibition. Physical
8 preparations for the conduct of the exhibition and cere-

- 1 mony shall be carried out in accordance with such condi-
- 2 tions as may be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol.
