- 4 tember 29, 2010, through Friday, November 12, 2010, on
- 5 a motion offered pursuant to this concurrent resolution
- 6 by its Majority Leader or his designee, it stand recessed
- 7 or adjourned until noon on Monday, November 15, 2010,
- 8 or such other time on that day as may be specified in the
- 9 motion to recess or adjourn, or until the time of any re-
- 10 assembly pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent resolu-
- 11 tion, whichever occurs first.
- 12 Sec. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
- 13 Leader of the Senate, or their respective designees, acting
- 14 jointly after consultation with the Minority Leader of the
- 15 House and the Minority Leader of the Senate, shall notify
- 16 the Members of the House and the Senate, respectively,
- 17 to reassemble at such place and time as they may des-
