Mr. DREIER (for himself, Mrs. NAPOLITANO, Ms. ROYBAL-ALLARD, and Mr. SCHIFF) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Natural Resources

A BILL

To authorize appropriations for the San Gabriel Basin
Restoration Fund.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SAN GABRIEL BASIN RESTORATION FUND.**

4 Section 110 of division B of the Miscellaneous Appro-
5 priations Act, 2001 (114 Stat. 2763A–222), as enacted
6 into law by section 1(a)(4) of the Consolidated Appropria-
7 tions Act, 2001 (Public Law 106–554, as amended by sec-
8 tion 202 of Public Law 107–66 (115 Stat. 500), section
9 204 of Public Law 108–7 (117 Stat. 145), and section

1 6013(b) of Public Law 109–13 (119 Stat. 283)), is fur-
2 ther amended—

3 (1) in subsection (a)(3)(B), by inserting after
4 clause (iii) the following:

5 “(iv) NON-FEDERAL MATCH.—After
6 \$85,000,000 has cumulatively been appro-
7 priated under subsection (d)(1), the re-
8 mainder of Federal funds appropriated
9 under subsection (d) shall be subject to the
10 following matching requirement:

11 “(I) SAN GABRIEL BASIN WATER
12 QUALITY AUTHORITY.—The San Ga-
13 briel Basin Water Quality Authority
14 shall be responsible for providing a 35
15 percent non-Federal match for Fed-
16 eral funds made available to the Au-
17 thority under this Act.

18 “(II) CENTRAL BASIN MUNICIPAL
19 WATER DISTRICT.—The Central Basin
20 Municipal Water District shall be re-
21 sponsible for providing a 35 percent
22 non-Federal match for Federal funds
23 made available to the District under
24 this Act.”;

1 (2) in subsection (a), by adding at the end the
2 following:

3 “(4) INTEREST ON FUNDS IN RESTORATION
4 FUND.—No amounts appropriated above the cumu-
5 lative amount of \$85,000,000 to the Restoration
6 Fund under subsection (d)(1) shall be invested by
7 the Secretary of the Treasury in interest-bearing se-
8 curities of the United States.”; and

9 (3) by amending subsection (d) to read as fol-
10 lows:

11 “(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

12 “(1) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be
13 appropriated to the Restoration Fund established
14 under subsection (a) \$146,200,000. Such funds shall
15 remain available until expended.

16 “(2) SET-ASIDE.—Of the amounts appropriated
17 under paragraph (1), no more than \$21,200,000
18 shall be made available to carry out the Central
19 Basin Water Quality Project.”.
