### A BILL

- To amend title 38, United States Code, to establish the position of Director of Physical Therapy Service within the Veterans Health Administration and to establish a fellowship program for physical therapists in the areas of geriatrics, amputee rehabilitation, polytrauma care, and rehabilitation research.

#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Physical5 Therapy Services Improvement Act of 2009".

#### 1 SEC. 2. FINDING.

2 The Congress finds that chronic conditions of the 3 aging veteran population and the complex impairments as-4 sociated with returning veterans from Operation Enduring 5 Freedom in Afghanistan and Operation Iraqi Freedom in 6 Iraq have increased the need to recruit and retain physical 7 therapists in the Veterans Health Administration.

# 8 SEC. 3. CREATION OF DIRECTOR OF PHYSICAL THERAPY 9 SERVICE.

Paragraph (6) of section 7306(a) of title 38, United

# 14 SEC. 4. QUALIFICATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT OF PHYSICAL 15 THERAPISTS.
