- 5 (a) In General.—Section 408(b) of the Robert T.
- 6 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
- 7 (42 U.S.C. 5174(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
- 8 following:

1	"(3) Eligibility of heirs of deceased
2	HOMEOWNERS.—In the event the owner of an owner-
3	occupied private residence dies, an heir taking legal
4	possession of the residence under applicable law
5	shall be eligible for assistance under subsections
6	(c)(2) and $(c)(3)$ in place of the deceased owner.".
7	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
8	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to a major disaster
9	declared by the President under the Robert T. Stafford
10	Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C.
11	5121 et seg ) on or after January 1 2008
