 7 None of the funds appropriated or otherwise made
- 8 available to any Federal department or agency may be

- 1 used to transfer any individual detained by the United
- 2 States at Naval Station, Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, to any
- 3 military installation located in the State of Florida or any
- 4 Federal detention center located in the State of Florida
- 5 or to house any such individual at such an installation or
