## A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to update certain procedures applicable to commerce in firearms and remove certain Federal restrictions on interstate firearms transactions.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Firearms Interstate  
5       Commerce Reform Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO CONDUCT INTERSTATE FIREARMS**  
2 **TRANSACTIONS.**

3 (a) **FIREARMS DISPOSITIONS.**—Section 922(b)(3) of  
4 title 18, United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by striking “rifle or shotgun” and inserting  
6 “firearm”; and

7 (2) in subparagraph (A)—

8 (A) by striking “located,” and inserting  
9 “located or temporarily located,”; and

10 (B) by striking “both such States” and in-  
11 serring “the State in which the transfer is con-  
12 ducted and the State of residence of the trans-  
13 feree”.

14 (b) **DEALER LOCATION.**—Section 923 of such title is  
15 amended—

16 (1) in subsection (j)—

17 (A) in the first sentence, by striking “, and  
18 such location is in the State which is specified  
19 on the license”; and

20 (B) in the last sentence—

21 (i) by inserting “transfer,” after  
22 “sell,”;

23 (ii) by striking all that follows “Act”  
24 and inserting a period; and

25 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1       “(m) Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to  
2 prohibit the sale, transfer, delivery, or other disposition  
3 of a firearm or ammunition—

4               “(1) by a person licensed under this chapter to  
5 another person so licensed, at any location in any  
6 State; or

7               “(2) by a licensed importer, licensed manufac-  
8 turer, or licensed dealer to a person not licensed  
9 under this chapter, at a temporary location de-  
10 scribed in subsection (j) in any State.”.
