A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a process for determining whether a geographic area is sufficiently served by the national cemeteries located in that geographic area.

- Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

 SECTION 1. DETERMINATION BY SECRETARY OF VETERANS

 AFFAIRS OF WHETHER A GEOGRAPHIC AREA

 IS SERVED BY NATIONAL CEMETERIES LOCATED IN THAT AREA.

 (a) PROCESS REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Veterans
- 8 Affairs shall establish a process for determining whether

- 1 a geographic area is sufficiently served by the national

- 3 shall take into account each of the following:
- 4 (1) The number of veterans living in the geo-5 graphic area.
- 6 (2) The average distance a resident of the geo-7 graphic area must travel to reach the nearest na-

- 9 (3) The population density of the geographic area.
- 11 (4) The average amount of time it takes a resi-12 dent of the geographic area to travel to the nearest 13 national cemetery.
 - (5) The availability of public transportation for purposes of traveling to national cemeteries located in the geographic area.
- 17 (6) The average amount of any fees charged to
 18 an individual traveling on the major roads leading to
 19 the national cemeteries located in the geographic
 20 area.
- 21 (b) Consideration of Alternatives.—In the case
- 22 of a geographic area in which sufficient land is not avail-
- 23 able to the Secretary for the establishment of a cemetery,

- 1 the Secretary shall consider alternatives to establishing a
- 2 cemetery, including establishing a mausoleum.
