AN ACT

- To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for research on acquired bone marrow failure diseases, minority-focused programs on such diseases, and the development of best practices for diagnosis of and care for individuals with such diseases.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Acquired Bone Marrow
3 Failure Disease Research and Treatment Act of 2010".
4 SEC. 2. ACQUIRED BONE MARROW FAILURE DISEASE RE5 SEARCH.

6 Part B of title III of the Public Health Service Act
7 (42 U.S.C. 243 et seq.) is amended by inserting after sec8 tion 317T the following:

9 "SEC. 317U. ACQUIRED BONE MARROW FAILURE DISEASE 10 RESEARCH.

11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may conduct re12 search on acquired bone marrow failure diseases. Such re13 search may address factors including—

"(1) trends in the characteristics of individuals
who are diagnosed with acquired bone marrow failure diseases, including age, race and ethnicity, general geographic location, sex, family history, and any
other characteristics determined appropriate by the
Secretary;

"(2) the genetic and environmental factors, including exposure to toxins, that may be associated
with developing acquired bone marrow failure diseases;

24 "(3) approaches to treating acquired bone mar25 row failure diseases;

2 quired bone marrow failure diseases, including out-3 comes for recipients of stem cell therapeutic prod-4 ucts; and "(5) any other factors pertaining to acquired 5 6 bone marrow failure diseases determined appropriate 7 by the Secretary. "(b) Collaboration With the Radiation Injury 8 TREATMENT NETWORK.—In carrying out subsection (a), 9 the Secretary may collaborate with the Radiation Injury 10 11 Treatment Network of the C.W. Bill Young Cell Transplantation Program established pursuant to section 379 12 13 to— "(1) augment data for the studies under such 14 15 subsection; (2) access technical assistance that may be 16 17 provided by the Radiation Injury Treatment Net-18 work; or 19 "(3) perform joint research projects. "(c) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term 'ac-20 21 quired bone marrow failure disease' means-22 "(1) myelodysplastic syndromes (MDS);

23 "(2) aplastic anemia;

24 "(3) paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria25 (PNH);

"(4) outcomes for individuals treated for ac-

2	"(5) acute myeloid leukemia that has pro-

9	SEC. 3. MINORITY-FOCUSED PROGRAMS ON ACQUIRED
10	BONE MARROW FAILURE DISEASES.
11	Title XVII of the Public Health Service Act (42)
12	U.S.C. 300u et seq.) is amended by inserting after section
13	1707A the following:
14	"SEC. 1707B. MINORITY-FOCUSED PROGRAMS ON AC-
15	QUIRED BONE MARROW FAILURE DISEASES.
16	"(a) Information and Referral Services.—
17	"(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary may estab-
18	lish and coordinate outreach and informational pro-
19	grams targeted to minority populations, including
20	Hispanic, Asian-American, Native Hawaiian, and
21	Pacific Islander populations, that are affected by ac-
22	quired bone marrow failure diseases.
23	"(2) PROGRAM ACTIVITIES.—Programs under
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	subsection (a) may carry out activities that in-

1	"(A) making information about treatment
2	options and clinical trials for acquired bone
3	marrow failure diseases publicly available; and
4	"(B) providing referral services for treat-
5	ment options and clinical trials.
6	"(b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term 'ac-
7	quired bone marrow failure disease' has the meaning given
8	such term in section 317U(c).".
9	SEC. 4. BEST PRACTICES FOR DIAGNOSIS OF AND CARE
10	FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH ACQUIRED BONE
11	MARROW FAILURE DISEASES.
12	Part B of title III of the Public Health Service Act
13	(42 U.S.C. 243 et seq.), as amended by section 2, is fur-
14	ther amended by inserting after section 317U the fol-
15	lowing:
16	"SEC. 317V. BEST PRACTICES FOR DIAGNOSIS OF AND CARE
17	FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH ACQUIRED BONE
18	MARROW FAILURE DISEASES.
19	"(a) GRANTS.—The Secretary, acting through the
20	Director of the Agency for Healthcare Research and Qual-
21	ity, may award grants to researchers to study best prac-
22	tices with respect to diagnosing acquired bone marrow
23	failure diseases and providing care to individuals with such

24 diseases.

"(b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term 'ac quired bone marrow failure disease' has the meaning given
 such term in section 317U(c).".
