A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of the Navy to convey the former Navy Extremely Low Frequency communications project site in Republic, Michigan, to Humboldt Township in Marquette County, Michigan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, FORMER NAVY EX-**
4 **TREMELY LOW FREQUENCY COMMUNICA-**
5 **TIONS PROJECT SITE, REPUBLIC, MICHIGAN.**

6 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
7 the Navy may convey, without consideration, to Humboldt
8 Township in Marquette County, Michigan, all right, title,

1 and interest of the United States in and to a parcel of
2 real property, including any improvements thereon, in Re-
3 public, Michigan, consisting of approximately 7 acres and
4 formerly used as an Extremely Low Frequency commu-
5 nications project site.

6 (b) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
7 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
8 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
9 factory to the Secretary.

10 (c) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
11 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-
12 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
13 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
14 interests of the United States.

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
