Mr. LUCAS (for himself and Mr. NEUGEBAUER) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the Clean Air Act to prohibit the issuance of permits under title V of that Act for certain emissions from agricultural production.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON PERMITTING CERTAIN EMIS-**
4 **SIONS FROM AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTION.**

5 Section 502(f) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
6 7661a(f)) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (1) through
8 (3) as subparagraphs (A) through (C), respectively,
9 and indenting such subparagraphs and the matter

1 following subparagraph (C), as so redesignated, ap-
2 propriately;

3 (2) by striking the subsection designation and
4 heading and all that follows through “No partial”
5 and inserting the following:

6 “(f) PROHIBITIONS.—

7 “(1) PARTIAL PERMIT PROGRAMS.—No par-
8 tial”; and

9 (3) by adding at the end the following:

10 “(2) CERTAIN EMISSIONS FROM AGRICULTURAL
11 PRODUCTION.—No permit shall be issued under a
12 permit program under this title for any carbon diox-
13 ide, nitrogen oxide, water vapor, or methane emis-
14 sions resulting from biological processes associated
15 with livestock production.”.
