OPTIONAL MEDICAID COVERAGE OF LOW-INCOME 4 5 HIV-INFECTED INDIVIDUALS. 6 (a) In General.—Section 1902 of the Social Secu-7 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a) is amended— 8 (1) in subsection (a)(10)(A)(ii)— (A) by striking "or" at the end of sub-9 10 clause (XVIII); (B) by adding "or" at the end of subclause 11 12 (XIX); and 13 (C) by adding at the end the following: 14 "(XX) who are described in subsection (dd) (re-15 lating to HIV-infected individuals);"; and 16 (2) by adding at the end the following: 17 "(dd) individuals described in this subsection are individuals not described in subsection (a)(10)(A)(i)— 18 19 "(1) who have HIV infection; "(2) whose income (as determined under the 20 21 State plan under this title with respect to disabled 22 individuals) does not exceed the maximum amount 23 of income a disabled individual described in sub-24 section (a)(10)(A)(i) may have and obtain medical

"section 1396d(b)) is amended by striking 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)(XVIII)" 10 and inserting "subclause (XVIII) or (XX) of section 1902(a)(10)(A)(ii)". 12 (c) Conforming Amendments.—Section 1905(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(a)) is amended in the matter preceding paragraph (1)— 14 15 (1) by striking "or" at the end of clause (xii); (2) by adding "or" at the end of clause (xiii); 16 17 and 18 (3) by inserting after clause (xiii) the following: 19 "(xiv) individuals described in section 20 1902(dd);". 21 (d) Exemption From Funding Limitation for 22 Territories.—Section 1108(g) of the Social Security 23 Act (42 U.S.C. 1308(g)) is amended by adding at the end the following:
