A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to prohibit the recovery by the United States of charges from a third party for hospital care or medical services furnished to a veteran for a service-connected disability.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Veterans Healthcare
5 Commitment Act of 2009”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON RECOVERY BY THE UNITED**
2 **STATES OF CHARGES FROM A THIRD PARTY**
3 **FOR TREATMENT OF VETERANS' SERVICE-**
4 **CONNECTED DISABILITIES.**

5 Section 1729 of title 38, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsection (i) as subsection
8 (k); and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (h) the fol-
10 lowing new subsection (i):

11 “(i) Nothing in this section authorizes the United
12 States to recover or collect any charges from any third
13 party for care or services furnished to a veteran under
14 this chapter for a service-connected disability.”.

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
